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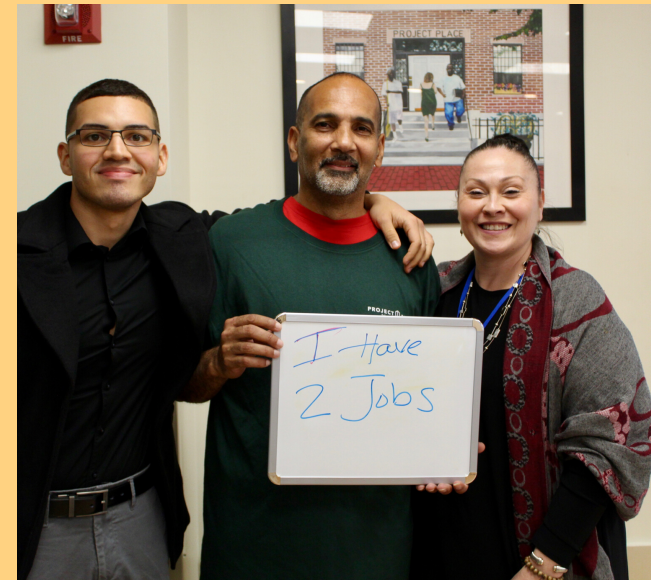

Industry Training. Clients in our Industry Internship Program receive on-the-job training within one of Project Place's three transitional employment programs:

- **Clean Corners...Bright Hopes** - maintenance and janitorial services
- **LEAP** - Vending and delivery services
- **Working Opportunities for Women** - Small business operation

Credentialing. Opportunities are available to clients to enhance their resume with credentials such as OSHA 10, ServSafe and MassAllergen, Commercial Drivers Licensing, Forklift/Hoisting and Customer Service.

Career Counseling. Client's workplace skills and interests are assessed, then paired with labor market needs. One-on-one career counseling is provided to each client.

Workshops. Enrichment workshops including financial literacy, nutrition, and housing resources are provided several times per week to provide life skills.

Alumni Relationships. Our clients are most successful when they engage in ongoing support – whether through case management, attendance at workshops or alumni gatherings. Our doors are always open to clients who want to re-engage in services at any level.

Career Services focuses on providing not just a temporary job, but a future via sustainable career pathways. The Career Services team organizes regular career development events:

- Monthly job fairs hosted at Project Place with employer partners
- Monthly field trips to MassHire Boston for extended employment opportunities
